

YOUTH TRAINING PROGRAMMES

Youth training delivers foundation skills and employment skills in a practical and interesting way. Students are assisted to pathway on to further training or employment in their chosen field. One course has a Maori focus and the other pathways to jobs in carpentry and related trades.

Career Pathways (carpentry) National Certificate in Employment Skills, level 1

Ak-T-v8 (youth course) National Certificate in Employment Skills, level 1

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Programme Aim & Pathways:

Designed to build confidence and self belief in the individual a major component of the training involves physical challenges such as abseiling and kayaking. Students explore job options and opportunities then learn about necessary prerequisites for employment. The course operates under a Maori kaupapa and teaches students through a Maori world view.

Pathways include further training or employment in the individuals chosen field.

Programme Content:

Explore job options, plan for future, self development and self managements, communication skills, literacy and numeracy, Taha Maori, workplace health & safety, interview skills, physical activities, employment skills, work experience placements.

Career Pathways (carpentry) National Certificate in Employment Skills, level 1

Programme Aim & Pathways:

- To provide a specialised learning environment for carpentry, building and related trades that is industry specific and relevant.
- A specific employment focus into the building industry, mainly carpentry and related trades.
- To help students to develop the skills needed to gain employment in a workplace that uses these skills in its everyday business.
- To assist students to go into further training (where appropriate) to develop a clear pathway into specialised careers within the above areas. It is anticipated that the majority of learners will move into employment.
- Pathways into further training within Unitec

Programme Content:

Based on the National Certificate in Employment Skills level 2, content will include: communication skills, work & study skills, self-management, literacy and numeracy, Occupational Health & Safety, use of tools and machinery and work experience in a range of enterprises in the general trades sectors. Units are mostly level one and two.
